## Dress Code Guidelines

### Purpose

To ensure all team members present themselves in a manner that reflects the values of our Islamic school, promotes unity, and maintains a professional appearance during off campus events, practices, and travel.

### General Principles

- **Modesty:** Clothing must align with Islamic principles of modesty.
- **Professionalism:** Attire should reflect the seriousness and formality of event settings.
- **Uniformity:** A coordinated look helps build team identity and cohesion.

### For All Team Members

- **Colors:** Neutral or school-approved colors (e.g., navy, black, white, grey, maroon).
- **Logos:** School or team logo may be worn; avoid large brand logos or slogans.
- **Accessories:** Minimal and non-distracting; no jewelry or makeup.
- **Shoes:** Closed-toe, clean, and professional (e.g., loafers, flats, dress shoes). No high heels.

### For Female Team Members

- **Hijab:** Should be neatly styled in solid or school-approved colors, draped to cover neck, ears and chest. The hijab should be non-transparent and secure.

- **Top:** Long-sleeved blouse or tunic that loosely drapes over the hips and is knee-length.
- **Bottom:** Loose-fitting trousers or ankle-length skirt (with leggings) socks are required.
- **Outerwear:** Optional blazer or cardigan for formal events.

## For Male Team Members

- **Top:** Collared shirt (long or short sleeve) tucked in; optional blazer for formal events.
- **Bottom:** Dress pants or chinos; no jeans or athletic wear.
- **Grooming:** Neat hair and facial grooming in line with school standards.

## Special Guidelines for Competitions

- **Formal Attire Required:** All members must wear the designated team uniform or formal dress code.
- **Team Identification:** Name tags or school badges must be worn (if specified)
- **No Casual Wear:** Hoodies, sneakers, or denim are not permitted during competitions.

## Exceptions

- Medical or religious accommodations will be respected with prior approval.
- Cultural attire may be incorporated if it aligns with modesty and professionalism.

## Enforcement

- Coaches and team leads will conduct periodic checks.
- Non-compliance may result in warnings or exclusion from events.
