

OUR FIRST FOOD DRIVE

Our first packaging was a Food Drive for 40-50 Afghani refugee families, resulting in a successful turn out!

Our goal and intention is not to just feed those in need, but to offer first aid to those who require it first hand.

- Rice
- Different types of lentils
- Oil
- Pasta
- Flour
- Dates
- Salt

And much more!







HYGIENE/FOOD KIT DISTRIBUTION

We also collaborated with the Al-Mahdi organization to package and distribute both hygiene kits AND food boxes, then proceeded to distribute them to those in need and the homeless in central downtown Houston.

These hygiene packs included:

- Sanitary wipes
- Sanitary pads
- Toothbrushes
- Socks
- First hand hygiene needs, etc!!

(We provide transportation for events and volunteers are able to contribute as well !!)







CLOTHING DRIVE

Another project we were able to move forward with was a Clothing drive, collaborating with the Haya Foundation,

where we collected over 100 bags of donated clothes from our generous community, all sorted by gender, material, etc.

The clothing donated had a variety of different materials, sizes, colors, cultures, etc., and all were brought to the Haya Foundation where they were donated back to those in need and refugees.

This project was one of our most successful and community based event, Thank you to those who contributed as well!!:))







SCHOOL SUPPLY DRIVE

Our most recent project was a School Supply drive:

We collected around 100 backpacks, filled them each with supplies, and proceeded to take them to a refugee Masjid for Afghani families.

The supplies consisted of:

- Glue sticks
- Notebooks
- Pencils
- Erasers
- Rulers
- Paper
- Etc. !!

Alhamdulillah, all of our backpacks were collected with no extras!!








VOLUNTEER HOURS AND ELIGIBILITY
