About Al-Hadi

**Mission:** Provide academic excellence for all students in a safe and healthy environment following Islamic values.

**Vision:** To foster students' optimal potential and leadership skills by inculcating a spirit of lifelong learning based on Islamic principles.

Al-Hadi School of Accelerative Learning is a SACS/Cognia accredited, full-time private Islamic school, established in 1996 and located in Houston, Texas. Al-Hadi School maintains an average enrollment of 600+ students from diverse backgrounds. Academically, the school offers accelerated and Advanced Placement courses and has significant student achievements in numerous standardized exams including but not limited to IOWAs, APs, PSAT, SAT, and ACT. Non-academically, the school strives to offer many extracurricular offerings such as karate, team sports, STEM-based competitions, honor societies, leadership opportunities, and more to enhance the student experience.

About the Outdoor Enrichment Program

Launching in Fall 2024, the Outdoor Enrichment Program is a new program at Al-Hadi that seeks to provide our youngest K-12 learners with more opportunities to learn outside of the confines of a classroom. During the 2024-2025 school year, the program will be specifically tailored to Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade students. Through the program, our KG and 1<sup>st</sup> grade students will spend two blocks of the day rotating through various outdoor modules, including an outdoor garden, a sandbox, a theater/storytelling module, and a structured outdoor games module. Each module will have an assigned coordinator, who will be responsible for planning and executing a curriculum pertaining to that module.

Responsibilities:

1. Serve as the primary point person for your chosen module (outdoor garden, sandbox, theater, or structured games).
2. Research, plan, and implement an approximately 7-month curriculum pertaining to your chosen module (garden, sandbox, theater, or structured games).
3. Communicate and partner in a timely manner with KG and 1<sup>st</sup> grade homeroom teachers and other Al-Hadi staff regarding logistical matters as needed (supplies, scheduling, etc.)
4. Inculcate a love of play, wonder, and the outdoors in Al-Hadi's youngest learners.

Preferred Qualifications:

1. Passion, excitement, and enthusiasm for outdoor, play-based learning.
2. Demonstrated competence in your chosen module (garden, sandbox, theater, or structured games)

3. Previous experience teaching young children in an educational setting, preferably a K-12 school environment.
4. Familiarity with Islamic principles and values, and willingness to integrate them into learning outcomes, where applicable.
5. Strong interpersonal skills and ability to build relationships with young students.
6. Willing to work under the guidance of school religious and administrative leadership.

Time Commitment:

Approximately 4-8 hours per module on our Richmond campus per week, for two to four days a week, between November 2024 and May 2025 (note: the Outdoor Enrichment Program is currently unavailable at our Voss location). The schedule can be flexible.
